Our first public health pilot, designed around social connection.




Provincial recognition for our work in improving home care accessibility, especially in rural and remote communities




Deeper relationships with communities and patients who have long felt forgotten by traditional systems.

### Gotcare Plus: Connecting Isolated Seniors

Launched in collaboration with Women's College Hospital, the In the Community (ITC) Program was our first public health pilot with Gotcare Plus.


The pilot focused on addressing social isolation and improving chronic disease self management in homebound older adults.

One participant summed it up best when asked why she joined:

### "I'm so lonely it hurts."

This pilot offers more than services — it offers **dignity**, **connection**, **and continuity of care**. Designed for when life changes overnight — whether from an accident, a serious diagnosis, or a complex recovery, families and older adults need more than just traditional home care.

Gotcare Plus combines high-tech digital monitoring with high-touch in-person support to move older adults with complex chronic conditions safely home within 12-24 hours of referral or discharge.



## Gotcare Recognized by the Ontario Centre of Innovation

In 2023, Gotcare was recognized through the **Ontario Life Sciences Innovation Fund (LSIF)**, administered by the **Ontario Centre of Innovation (OCI)**.

The fund was created to accelerate made-in-Ontario health solutions by supporting early-stage companies addressing system-level challenges in care delivery, equity, and innovation.

Gotcare was recognized for our work improving home care access, particularly in rural and underserved communities, and for using technology to help more people remain safely at home while easing pressure on the healthcare system.

...which has helped us strengthen our community relationships and foster a culture of care that extends directly to our clients.

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
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## Personal Story: A Holiday Meal in Nipissing First Nation
